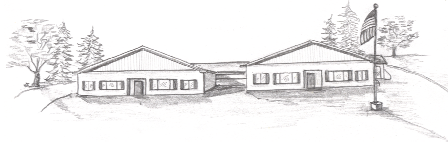

Appendix F

Wyoming County Community Action WIOA Eligible Supportive Services Policy

A limit of \$600 is available for supportive service costs per program year and dependent on the availability of funding. Costs must be documented and supported as necessary and specific to the training and/or occupational goal of the customer. Services that will be covered include:

- Testing Fees / Licensing/Certification Fees / Finger Printing
- Clothing and other work related items required by ITA/OJT/CT/or Pre-Hire
 - Uniform expense limit - \$100.00
 - Shoe expense Limit - \$125.00
- Mileage Reimbursement limited to ITA Participants
- Other services as deemed appropriate based upon demonstrated need and approved by the WCCA Exec. Director.

In addition to Services listed above the following additional supportive services are available to WIOA eligible youth:

- Benchmark attainment incentive payments:
 - Attainment of TASC, High School Equivalency \$50.00
 - NWRC Certification \$50.00
 - WorkKeys skill assessment completion – earning either a Bronze Silver or Gold rating. \$25.00
 - ServSafe (Food Handler Certification) \$25.00
 - Fork Lift Certification \$25.00
 - Completion of Work Readiness Training Workshops \$25.00 per workshop
 - Completion of the 5 Career Zone Modules required to meet CSI performance benchmark \$25.00
- Transportation assistance:
 - Available to youth enrolled in work experience, or other employment related activities.
 - Youth enrolled in work experience activities may receive assistance until their first paycheck is received.
