

# **GLOW Workforce Development Board (WDB) Policy**

Under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

**Name of Policy:** Blanket Transfer of WIOA Funds of up to 100% Between Adult and Dislocated Worker (DW) Programs

**Approval Date:** 3/17/26

**Effective Date:** 3/18/26

---

**Background:** Under WIOA Section 133(b)(4), a Local WDB may now transfer up to 100% of funds between the Adult and DW funding streams.

**Recommendation:** Each year during the September meeting (provided a quorum is reached), the GLOW WDB will approve a blanket transfer of up to 100% between Adult and DW programs as allowed by WIOA and New York State Department of Labor (NYSDOL) Workforce Development System Technical Advisory #17-06. This will provide more flexibility to serve both the Adult and DW populations. No eligible participant will be denied services, including training services, due to lack of funds, because of this transfer. NYSDOL Program and Financial Oversight and Technical Assistance (FOTA) staff will ensure that funds are being spent as required prior to approving any requests. This “blanket transfer” of 100% between Adult and DW programs will allow GLOW to make requests up to 100% as needed. The GLOW WDB Executive Director will ensure that all transfers are communicated to the Board during all finance committee and Board meetings.
