



ADULT SERVICES




- **Adult Basic Education prepares students for the high school equivalency diploma.**

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS


- Must be at least 16 years of age**

This includes providing strong support systems and initiating services that meet the needs of our clients. Community partnerships are significant to the growth and prosperity of our organization.


